Specimen Collection Notes: SPUTUM: 10ml first morning sputum or induced sputum (not saliva). Three sputum collections are recommended for patients w/ clinical and chest xray findings compatible with tuberculosis. Stable 24 hours @ room temp. URINE: Three consecutive clean voided early morning specimens (50ml each). Refrig immediately after collection. Stable 24 hours refrigerated.
