BARIATRIC SERVICES

Evangelical's bariatric program includes gastric bypass and sleeve gastrectomy, and is accredited by the Bariatric Surgery Center Network (BSCN) Accreditation Program of the American College of Surgeons (ACS).

CARDIOPULMONARY SERVICES

Areas of expertise include EEG (electroencephalography), EKG (electrocardiography), respiratory therapy, and pulmonary rehabilitation.

HEART AND VASCULAR SERVICES

Evangelical's catheterization suite features advanced cardiovascular technology in two catheterization laboratories, a seven room procedure unit, and a cardiac rehabilitation department.

THE FAMILY PLACE/OBSTETRICS

The Family Place meets the unique needs of mothers and babies through family-centered maternity care, from labor and delivery to postpartum care. In addition to vaginal deliveries, the staff is prepared to handle cesarean births or vaginal birth after cesarean (VBAC).

IMAGING SERVICES

Our licensed technologists and board-certified radiologists use state-of-the-art equipment and offer a full range of imaging services 24 hours a day, including standard imaging, CT, MRI, PET/CT, and SPECT-CT.

LABORATORY SERVICES

Our laboratory completes over 1.2 million individual tests each year through its eight locations in our service area. We are accredited by the College of American Pathologists.

CENTER FOR ORTHOPAEDICS

The specialists at Evangelical, including eight board certified surgeons, offer expertise in hip, knee, shoulder, hand, elbow, and spine injuries. Evangelical's services include total joint replacement, physical therapy, MRI, and post-surgical support.

PHYSICAL REHABILITATION

Our rehabilitation staff is highly trained to treat patients who have had a stroke or other neurological diagnoses, total joint replacements, fractures, trauma, amputations, general weakness and debilitation, and compromised cardiovascular and respiratory function.

PRIMARY AND COMPREHENSIVE STROKE CENTER

As a certified Primary Stroke Center and a comprehensive stroke care affiliation with Penn State Hershey Medical Center, Evangelical offers 24/7 multidisciplinary stroke care. That includes the Telestroke System in the Emergency Department.

SURGICAL SERVICES

Evangelical's surgical suite features eight spacious operating rooms with leading-edge technology, including a hybrid OR. The nearby Ambulatory Surgical Center includes four OR suites as well.

THYRA M. HUMPHREYS CENTER FOR BREAST HEALTH

The Center offers a full spectrum of clinical and support services, in an atmosphere that has been designed with women in mind. It features the latest 3D technology and whole breast ultrasound.

URGENT CARE

Urgent Care of Evangelical offers a lower-cost option for treating non-life-threatening medical needs. Urgent care fills the gap between Emergency Department visits and times when a primary healthcare provider is unavailable. In a no-appointment-needed environment, urgent care offers patients extended hours, shorter wait times, onsite X-ray, and specimen collection for lab testing.
