Balloon Sinuplasty

Evangelical Community Hospital is one of the only facilities in the Susquehanna Valley to offer Balloon Sinuplasty™, an innovative procedure to relieve symptoms of chronic sinusitis. Balloon Sinuplasty is a safe and effective procedure that can provide relief to patients suffering from sinusitis symptoms that are not responding well to medications.


Less invasive than traditional sinus surgery, Balloon Sinuplasty does not include removal of bone or tissue from the nose. Patients experience less pain and faster recovery times than with traditional sinus surgery.

Similar to balloon angioplasty, this breakthrough procedure uses a small, flexible balloon catheter to open sinus passageways to facilitate drainage and relieve sinus pain and pressure. Balloon Sinuplasty is typically performed under general anesthesia in an outpatient setting.


Immediate Access, Convenient Scheduling

Scheduling an appointment is easy and hassle-free. Emergency appointments are always available and will be scheduled within 24-48 hours for urgent/emergent care. All appointments – pre-op, surgery, and post-op – are scheduled simultaneously.

BALLOON SINUPLASTY OPENS BLOCKED SINUS CAVITIES IN FOUR EASY STEPS:



1 A guide wire and balloon catheter are inserted into the inflamed sinus



2 The balloon is inflated to expand the sinus opening



3 Saline is sprayed into the infected sinus cavity to flush out pus and mucus



4 The system is removed, leaving the sinuses open
