Treatments

We offer treatment options for:

- Heavy/irregular menstrual bleeding
- Fibroids of the uterus
- Cysts in the fallopian tubes
- Ovarian cysts
- Endometriosis

Surgical Procedures

- Hysterectomy (removal of the uterus). Hysterectomies can be performed with or without removing one or both fallopian tubes and ovaries and through a number of different surgical approaches (vaginal, laparoscopic, or abdominal).
- Surgeries of the fallopian tubes and/or ovaries. This may include treatment or removal of ovarian cysts, removal of the tubes/ovaries, surgery for an ectopic (tubal) pregnancy, and tubal ligation (tying of tubes)/sterilization.
- Surgeries of the vulva and perineum (external female anatomy)
- Surgeries of the vagina and cervix. This can include biopsies and repair of cystocele and rectocele (bulging of the bladder or rectum into the vagina).
- Surgeries of the uterus. This can include biopsies, dilatation & curettage (D&C), hysteroscopy (looking inside the uterus with a scope inserted through the cervix), removal of fibroids, and endometrial ablation (treatment for heavy menstrual bleeding) using the NovaSure® (www.novasure.com) procedure.
