# A TRULY EPIC MOVE

At the close of 2022, Evangelical Community Hospital successfully transitioned to one, integrated platform for its electronic health record (EHR). The Hospital moved to Epic, a leading developer of comprehensive healthcare software used by numerous academic medical centers around the world.

As a result, all of the Hospital's workstreams—inpatient, outpatient, Emergency Department, Operating Rooms, and more—now operate on the same platform, modernizing the patient experience with a seamless, safe, and more consistent healthcare delivery system for all patients in the community.

The transition to Epic affords opportunities for quality improvements, best-in-class patient experiences, and the efficient intake of new patients as well as ensuring existing patients are where they need to be to receive the best possible care in a timely manner.

"The platform takes into consideration all facets related to patient care and has placed them into one system that makes seeing all information in one place possible," said Malcolm Mar Fan, MD, Medical Director of the Hospitalist Group, Evangelical's inpatient provider team. "For our clinical staff, this means no longer

logging out of one system into another to get all the information needed to care for our patients. For our patients, it means better access to their own information and smoother sharing of vital medical data and test/imaging results with providers outside of the Evangelical system for seamless care experiences."

The implementation of Epic included a switch to Epic's patient portal, MyChart. After registering for an account, patients are able to access their medical records, see test results, talk to their care teams, request prescription refills, request referrals to specialists, receive reminders for important health screenings, and more.

In the near future, Evangelical patients participating in MyChart will have the ability to schedule appointments with their established care teams through the portal.



A system migration of this scope—which truly impacted every electronic system at the Hospital and its group of primary and specialty care practices—requires a complete team effort. It culminated December 4, 2022, after more than two years of planning, testing, and training. And despite some not-unexpected hiccups shortly after going live, it has been successful.

"I've been a part of a number of these types of transition projects in my career, and this one, by far, was the smoothest," said Elizabeth Price, Vice President of Information Systems/CIO. "It's a testament to the teams who worked to construct the workflows in the new system, the providers and staff who diligently completed the training, and everyone who provided support as we moved to the new EHR."

Now that Epic is in place, the Information Technology team, in conjunction with providers and staff, has been working to resolve any remaining issues, refine workflows, develop order sets, and adapt procedures to meet the needs of Evangelical specifically.

"Implementing an integrated EHR was a significant investment of financial and staff resources, but it was absolutely vital to ensure Evangelical continues to deliver the high quality of care the community has come to expect of us," said Kendra Aucker, President and CEO.

# STAYING CONNECTED WITH THE WORKFORCE

Maintaining an exceptional workforce through creating a caring, compassionate environment that centers on respect and inclusion makes Evangelical the hospital it is for the community. ### COFFEE WITH KENDRA

At Evangelical, it's not about assuming what the employees need in a workplace but asking them. Kendra Aucker, President and CEO, held hour-long sessions with small groups of employees—usually between 8 and 10 at a time from 2022 through 2023—capturing a large majority of the workforce. During the sessions, those conversations centered around celebrating what the Hospital is doing right, current challenges facing the workforce, current and future Hospital initiatives, and identifying ways the Hospital can do even better for its employees and patients.

The information gleaned from those sessions has driven many of the initiatives taken by the Hospital throughout fiscal year 2023 and continues to guide the narrative for leadership.

## CREATING A 'SAFE TO CARE' WORK ENVIRONMENT

Employees should expect to be safe when they are doing their jobs. According to the National Crime Victimization Survey, healthcare workers are 20% more likely to be the victim of workplace violence than workers in other industries. The American Nurses Association found that 25% of surveyed nurses reported being physically assaulted by a patient or a patient's family member. The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, the Occupational Safety and Health Administration, The Joint Commission, as well as other accrediting organizations and professional associations have been tracking increases in aggressive, violent behavior toward healthcare workers.

Within the Hospital's walls, there has been a marked uptick in rude and aggressive behaviors as well as physical altercations. These have resulted in increased calls for assistance to security personnel.

To encourage the safest environment possible for Hospital employees, the Safe to Care program was introduced. Safe to Care saw a renaming of the Hospital's security team to Employee and Public Safety to clearly define their role at the Hospital. In addition, the following initiatives were implemented or put into planning:

- New uniforms to make security personnel easier to identify
- Security assessments for every office and clinic
- A new mass communication system that will streamline the ability to communicate security issues to every employee, provider, and volunteer
- A new app that will facilitate calls to 9-1-1, connect to a public safety tip line, and allow employees to select a guardian to track their arrival and departure at a designated location

- Improvements to the system-wide security assist buttons
- Quarterly emergency preparedness reviews with departments across the organization
- Updates to relevant policies, like the Patient and Visitor Code of Conduct and the Hospital's lockdown procedure
- Public-facing messaging that calls out and discourages rude, aggressive behavior
- Nationally recognized, in-person AVADE® training (depending on role) to help support collective safety and security while at work

## EMPLOYEE/PROVIDER ENGAGEMENT SURVEY

Employees had an additional opportunity to provide their points of view to leadership through the Employee/Provider Engagement Survey in June 2023. The pulse survey was a shortened tool that allowed employees and providers to share their feedback on areas the Hospital is working on to meet employees' needs.

The confidential survey ran for 17 days and asked questions that took approximately 10 minutes to complete.

Key strengths identified by respondents:

- Employees and providers feel respected
- Coworkers value individuals with different backgrounds
- The Hospital provides high-quality care and service

The survey results were collected by Press Ganey and will be evaluated and presented to leadership, who will guide efforts in the new fiscal year.

The survey serves to celebrate Hospital successes, identify ways to make the organization even better, and further shape a shared culture.



## CHAIR OF JOY

As the Hospital continues to see a high volume of patients and is challenged with staffing shortages, the mental and emotional well-being of employees has come keenly into view. It became clear in fiscal year 2023 that finding ways to give staff and providers outlets for stress relief was a high priority. A well workforce provides the best possible care to patients.

One innovative approach was introduced by Joyely LLC, a company driven by creating a joy-filled workplace. Evangelical enlisted Joyely to bring in its Chair of Joy. The ornate chair, along with the guidance of Joyely's Culture of Joy experts, encouraged employees to take the time to sit, breathe, think, and feel through the emotions of their day.

While the special chair was a means to take part in the four-step concept of joy, the exercise could be done in any chair, anywhere. The mission of the program is to cultivate joy, which is essential for effective leadership, fostering diversity and inclusion, increasing employee engagement, boosting productivity, and building resilience.

## EMPLOYEE APPRECIATION



## Recruitment:

Staff recruitment in a difficult employment landscape continues to challenge People and Culture and the Hospital to think outside the box on meeting job seekers' needs. Fiscal year 2023 saw continued reliance on contract labor to fill care gaps, allowing patients to receive the excellent healthcare

for which Evangelical is known. While the use of travelers and agency staff is a good short-term plan, it is not sustainable for long-term success. As a result, a concerted effort has been made to find staffing solutions in a landscape where there are more openings than people to fill them.



### EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN (EMT) TRAINING PROGRAM

First introduced in fiscal year 2022 and continuing in 2023, the EMT training program has successfully graduated two classes, bringing on a total of seven employees.

New in 2023 was a partnership with SUN Area Technical Institute. In the new collaboration, high school students pursuing criminal justice or health-related fields for Nurse Aide or Patient Care Technician can do their coursework at SUN Tech and then switch over to the EMT Training Program. Two students went through the SUN Tech/Evangelical collaborative program and began employment with Evangelical in the summer of 2023.

The four-month, fully funded EMT training program allows participants to gain knowledge and education through a partnership with Penn College. Upon completion and achievement of certifications, the graduates become EMTs with Evangelical Regional Mobile Medical Services, where they are mentored by established EMTs and Paramedics as they begin their careers.

## INTERNATIONAL STAFFING

New to the Hospital in fiscal year 2023 was the effort to recruit employees internationally. Through partnerships with PassportUSA and Conexus, Registered Nurse and Medical Laboratory Scientist candidates from other countries are able to interview for existing positions at the Hospital. Primarily from the Philippines, but also from the Bahamas and Nepal, these candidates have the same exceptional credentials and work experience as those in the United States; however, in their countries, there are more candidates than jobs available.

Once here, PassportUSA and Conexus help these employees and their families through the immigration process and establish themselves within the community (connections to housing, schools, transportation, places of worship, etc.). They are employees of these organizations for their first three years at the Hospital. Once that time commitment has been completed, these employees are offered full-time employment and become employees of Evangelical if they wish.

The introduction of international employees has been a success, with the Hospital's staff welcoming these individuals with open arms and minds.

At fiscal year's end, five RNs (two in Critical/Intermediate Care and three in Acute Care) were onboarded through the program. One Emergency Department RN is set to start at the end of summer 2023. It is anticipated that in fiscal year 2024, another 18 staff members will be added through the international initiative (three Medical Laboratory Scientists and 15 RNs).



## DIVERSITY, EQUITY, AND INCLUSION

As our population mix becomes more varied and rich in culture, the Hospital has reinforced its efforts toward diversity, equality, and inclusion (DEI) for all staff and patients who enter the doors. The initiative focuses on what patients and staff need in addition to an excellent care and work environment—a welcoming and accepting place to land regardless of background and belief.

As fiscal year 2023 progressed, several key developments were made in DEI efforts.

- Leveraged data to inform and shape DEI efforts
- Established a workgroup to guide the process focused on four pillars (talent, patients, providers, and community members)
- Created a dashboard to better understand trends in staff and patient demographics for the region
- Supported federally recognized heritage months centered on historically marginalized groups
- Introduced DEI questions on the Employment Engagement Survey
- Held a PRIDE panel discussion to aid in answering questions and gaining insight on connecting with the LGBTQ+ community

These efforts are moving the meter on a nurturing environment for people of all walks of life as early results from the 2023 Pulse Survey indicate that the Hospital's diversity index has moved to the 72nd percentile.

## HOSPITAL RECEIVES HONOR FOR SECOND TIME IN HISTORY

Congratulations to all Evangelical providers, employees, and volunteers on achieving a five-star rating on the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) rating system.

CMS updated its Overall Hospital Quality Star Ratings for 2023 and released the results on July 26, 2023. They awarded 483 U.S. hospitals with a rating of five stars, 18 of which, including Evangelical, are in the Pennsylvania listing. This year, 54 more hospitals were given five stars than in 2022.

CMS annually assigns star ratings to hospitals nationwide based on their performance across five quality categories—mortality, safety of care, readmission, patient experience, and timely and effective care.

# MAPPING OUT THE VISION OF CARE

Whether building new, revitalizing, or planning, a focus on patients continues to guide the Hospital's decisions. In fiscal year 2023, several construction projects showed the Hospital's commitment to access to care and allowing room for growth.

## HEART AND VASCULAR CENTER OF EVANGELICAL

Constructed and opened for patient care in 2015, the Heart and Vascular Center of Evangelical quickly filled its practice with patients seeking heart and vascular disease management and treatment from Evangelical's professionals. By 2022, it became clear the relatively new practice needed more space.

Fiscal year 2023 saw a renovation of the practice done in two phases. The first phase increased the number of exam rooms from nine to 14, added a procedure room, created a staff lounge, added an ADA-accessible restroom, and made room for more provider-shared office space.

The expansion increased the practice location by 7,980 feet, allowing for increased patient volume in new and modern spaces designed for patients and providers. After passing inspections, patients were enjoying the newly expanded spaces starting in January 2023.

The second phase focused on efficiency and space improvements in the check-in and check-out spaces of the main entrance and waiting area to better meet patient needs. That phase was completed in March 2023.



## SUSQUEHANNA VALLEY MALL

Work to complete new clinical spaces for SUN Orthopaedics of Evangelical's Selinsgrove office as well as Selinsgrove Imaging Center in the Susquehanna Valley Mall continued between 2022 and 2023.

Both the orthopaedics practice and the imaging center were relocated from nearby

21 Susquehanna Valley Mall Drive to the mall location adjacent to other medical offerings in what was the former Sears store location.

The move, while short in distance, provides convenient access for patients needing orthopaedic care or imaging services for

the Selinsgrove, Sunbury, and surrounding areas, especially those who are already seeking other healthcare services at the mall location.

The space was occupied and began seeing patients in August 2023.

The former home of SUN Orthopaedics of Evangelical and Selinsgrove Imaging Center will be used by the Hospital to bring even more services and access to the surrounding areas. Currently, plans are under way to bring multiple services to the clinic spaces in that building, beginning with OB/GYN in December 2023. More to come as plans continue to progress.



## COUNTRY CUPBOARD

In April 2022, the Hospital finalized its negotiations with the Baylor-Hamm Companies to purchase the former Country Cupboard Restaurant and Gift Shops property at the corner of Hafer Road and Route 15. The property, which is contiguous with other Hospital-owned property, is an excellent location for future development.

In October 2022, the Hospital began its demolition of the aging structure of the former restaurant, which would have required substantial improvements to make it viable for any future use. The plan to demolish the existing structure allowed for a fresh start in a cost-effective manner for the future. Several options have been explored, but no immediate plans for the site have been established.



# TAKING THE NEXT STEP IN ORTHOPAEDICS

## FOOT AND ANKLE CARE ADDED

Just as the strength of the body comes from the bones and muscles that are its foundation, the Hospital has found success from its orthopaedic specialties available through SUN Orthopaedics of Evangelical.

With nine board-certified orthopaedic surgeons on staff, complemented by a strong team of advanced practitioners and support staff, SUN Orthopaedics of Evangelical delivers on its strong reputation of answering the orthopaedic needs of the region.



In fiscal year 2023, SUN Orthopaedics of Evangelical added to its offerings through the arrival of Gerard Cush, MD, Foot and Ankle Surgeon.

Dr. Cush specializes in the treatment of sports-related injuries and fractures of the foot and ankle, ankle arthritis treatment, including total ankle replacement or fusion, flat foot/midfoot disorders, Achilles disorders, Hallux valgus (bunion) and great toe arthritis, lesser toe disorders, heel pain, nerve disorders, and other foot and ankle problems or pathology.

Dr. Cush joins his elite colleagues at SUN Orthopaedics of Evangelical in answering patients' needs in the areas of joint replacement, sports medicine, spine, and foot and ankle in five convenient locations, backed by Physical Therapy of Evangelical for pre- and post-surgical rehabilitation.

## THROUGH CHALLENGES, STAFF DISPLAY STRENGTH AND COMMITMENT

After three full years of delivering healthcare in a pandemic environment, the federal Public Health Emergency (PHE) for COVID-19, declared under Section 319 of the Public Health Service (PHS) Act, was called to an end by the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) on May 11, 2023.

For the Hospital's staff and providers, this was a welcome announcement. With an end to the pandemic declared, visitation opened, universal masking throughout the Hospital and its practices was lifted, and operations began to resume as they did before COVID-19.

Though the pandemic has ended, the impact on the staff is not easily forgotten. The lessons learned about flexing operations in challenging times to serve patient needs in the best way possible remain, and the resilience exhibited is celebrated.





## HOSPICE OF EVANGELICAL EARNS 5-STAR RATING

Hospice of Evangelical, a comprehensive program that assists patients and their families with physical, emotional, and spiritual needs that may accompany a life-limiting illness, was awarded the 5-Star rating by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS).

In all other categories, Hospice received 80 percent or higher.

# FINANCIAL REPORT

Evangelical Community Hospital remains committed to expanding access to its wide variety of services and providing the kind of personalized and high-quality care the community has come to expect—even in a challenging financial landscape.

The Hospital continues to be challenged by rising labor costs, specifically the utilization of contract labor; an aging population that requires higher levels of care but is no longer covered by private insurance; and patient volumes in primary and

specialty clinics that have not returned to pre-pandemic levels. Additionally, Evangelical is experiencing longer average lengths of stays for many patient populations and reimbursement rates from insurance providers that do not cover the cost of care.



## NET PATIENT REVENUE COMPARISON



In fiscal year 2023, Evangelical doubled down on its long-term commitment to the health and wellness of the community—transitioning to an integrated electronic health record (EHR), expanding its Heart and Vascular Center, recalibrating its talent recruitment initiatives, adding a foot and ankle specialist to its thriving orthopaedics practice, and improving access to its services in the Selinsgrove and Williamsport areas.

The Hospital successfully completed its transition to Epic, an integrated EHR platform, improving staff and provider efficiency across the organization while providing a more seamless experience for patients as they navigate between healthcare providers in the region.

The Heart and Vascular Center was expanded to accommodate more patients and more providers. Heart and Vascular continues to show gains in patient volumes, suggesting it's an area of need in the community and one of the Hospital's keys to regaining financial stability.

Significant investment is being made to modernize the Hospital's recruitment efforts, tapping into new communication channels and aggressively utilizing traditional recruitment methods to fill out its

teams and reduce its reliance on contract labor.




SUN Orthopaedics of Evangelical's Selinsgrove practice and the Selinsgrove Imaging Center have moved from the facility at

21 Susquehanna Valley Mall Drive to leased space in the Susquehanna Valley Mall that is adjacent to other healthcare providers. The new space provides ease of access for orthopaedic patients along with new and expanded imaging services.

Evangelical is expanding access to a variety of specialty practices and services at the 21 Susquehanna Valley Mall Drive location, strengthening care options for those in the Selinsgrove area. A second multi-specialty clinic is opening in Williamsport.

## TALK WITH THE DOC LECTURES


